Annual Lowcountry USBC meeting will be held on April 27th at 12:00 PM

RULES

- 1. This tournament is governed by USBC rules. Entry is open to all USBC bowlers that are members in good standing with the Lowcountry USBC Association. Bowlers that are not currently sanctioned through the Lowcountry USBC can obtain an unattached association card from the tournament directors. The fee for the unattached membership is \$14.00.
- 2. Entry fees will be \$40.00 per person.

(\$25.00 prize fund, \$14.00 lineage and \$1.00 expense fees).

- 3. Make checks payable to the Lowcountry USBC Association.
- 4. Prize fund will be determined by number of entries. Payout will be 1:10 entries.
- 5. Prize fees will be returned 100%.
- 6. Squad times will be: April 27-28 at 10:00 am & 1:30 pm.
- 7. Entries will close 30 minutes prior to the last squad, no exceptions!
- 8. You will bowl one three (3) game series on April 27-28.
- 9. Handicap will be 90% of 230.
- 10. Re-entries are permitted. You can only cash once in the top 5 and one other place overall in the tournament.

ENTERING AVERAGES:

- 1. Bowlers will use in order of precedence:
- 2. Their highest 2022-2023 USBC average of 21 games or more.
- 3. Current average of 21 games or more as of April 21, 2024.
- 4. All others will bowl scratch.
- 5. It will be each bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of the reported average on the entry form. Reporting an average that is lower than required resulting in higher handicap, or failure to make necessary corrections before completion of the first game, will disqualify the individual and they will forfeit their entry fee. If the submitted average is higher than required, that average will be used. (USBC Rule 319a 3 & 4).
- 6. USBC Rule 319a-2, the ten pin rule; and rule 319e will NOT apply for this tournament.
- 7. If you have won more than \$300 in any event or \$500 combined in any tournament or \$1000 combined in all tournaments over the last 12 months (USBC Rule 319d) you must report your winnings to the tournament director.
- 8. All rulings will be based on USBC rules, and the tournament director will decide any questions not covered by USBC rules, and that decision shall be final unless an appeal is made under USBC rule 329.
- 9. It shall be each bowler's responsibility to verify their scores for accuracy. Tournament workers will record scores. Protests will not be allowed once the score sheets have been signed and received by a tournament director. PLEASE CHECK YOUR SCORES!
- 10. All score corrections will be made by tournament officials or Lowcountry USBC Association directors only.
